Virtual Classrooms for School Aged Kids

Although our summer camp will be ending, we would like to let you know that we will be offering a virtual classroom setting for School Aged children starting August 17th.

Full time for School Aged children will run from 8am-3pm \$200/weekly.

Full time + after care will be 7am-5pm \$250/weekly.

We will ensure your student is logged in on time and participating in their online learning. They will have a teacher in the classroom to help bridge and misunderstandings and provide the one on one support their regular teachers cannot right now.

Meals, snacks and other activities will be provided; however, all students must bring their own computer or tablet.





Don't Forget! - LABEL, LABEL, LABEL

ALL of your child's belongings that come to school should have their **First Name and Last Initial** on them. This includes blankets, backpacks, diaper bags, cups/bottles, Etc.... If it is not labeled, we will label if for you.

JUST A FEW REMINDERS...

All Students over the age of 2yrs are required to wear **CLOSE TOED SHOES** to daycare. This rule is for their safety. As an added precaution, we ask that any **Infants** under 2yrs that are walking have a pair of shoes (**without laces**) with them as well.

PARENTS - DROP OFF/PICK UP: Please remember to **WEAR YOUR FACE MASK** during drop off and pick up. And **PRACTICE SOCIAL DISTANCING** when possible.

When to Return to School:

Fever free for 72
hours without
the use of fever
reducing
medication such
as ibuprofen or
acetaminophen

Cough is mild and infrequent and evaluated by doctor if needed Free from diarrhea and/or vomiting for at least 12 hours and evaluated by doctor if needed

Free from rash, itching or fever and evaluated by doctor if needed After first head lice treatment

24 hours after starting antibiotic eye drops or ointment
